

### **Section III – Soccer**

- National Federation Rules will be used.
- Two VHSL certified officials must be used for all games.
- Ties at the end of regulation time will be decided by two five minute over-time periods. If a tie still exists after overtime play occurs, it is recorded as a tie.

### **Section VII – Tournament Officiating**

#### Varsity

- Soccer – 3 officials

#### Specific rules per sport

#### Soccer

- Points will be awarded for determining the regular season standing. Two points for a win and one point for a tie.
- In case of a tie at the end of a regular season contest, it will remain a tie.
- During the tournament, two 5 minute overtimes will be played. If still tied, a 5 penalty kicks per team will determine the winner.
- Game times
  - Varsity – Two 40 minute halves
  - JV - Two 35 minute halves
  - MS - Two 30 minute halves
  - No slaughter rule
- Card rule: Two yellow cards will result in a red. A direct red – called hard red, the athlete will be ejected from the game on next conference contest with no substitution in current game.
