**The following rules will be used in District, Regional, and State playoff games.** • All games must have a winner; therefore, the following procedures will be used to break a tie. First two five-minute overtimes played to completion. Second, two five-minute sudden death overtimes -first score ends the game. Third – Kicks from the Mark tie breaker (These are different rules from FIFA) -Coaches designate 5 kickers to alternate kicks (**these five players can kick in any order as long as five different players kick**) -if still tied after five kicks, we go to one on one kicks coaches again designate five kickers (**NOTE THESE CAN BE THE SAME FIVE KICKERS AS THE FIRST GROUP AND AGAIN CAN KICK IN ANY ORDER**) **FIRST TEAM TO GAIN A ONE GOAL ADVANTAGE WINS.** (This is different than the rulebook as per VHSL coach's decision)

**Note: Soft/Hard Red Carded players CANNOT participate in the kicks.**

**Bull Run District uses the Mercy/Slaughter rules in tournament and regular season play.**

**Clark County HS is in the Region B for the regionals. Region B does NOT use the Mercy/Slaughter Rules.**

**Cedar Run uses the Mercy/Slaughter rules in the playoffs.**

**Dulles District uses the Mercy/Slaughter rules in the playoff**

**Northwestern District (NWD) uses the Mercy/Slaughter rules in the playoffs.**
